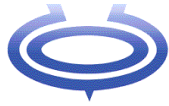

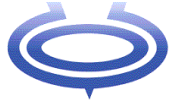

The Deaf Society of NSW (DSNSW) is seeking expressions of interest from professional graphic designers with commercial experience to perform freelance work with us on a contract basis.

The work is primarily print-based, preparing original layout designs for a bi-monthly bulletin. An essential requirement is that the graphic designer/s shall be familiar with the Deaf community's language and cultural trends in order to produce the bulletin.

There will be some need to produce graphics for the web. DSNSW will provide the articles and photographs. All work will be on short deadlines.
